

The following opinion, rendered upon a reconsideration of the decision of June 21, 1889, in the case of Rowland M. Jones, appealed by his widow, Julia W. (page 72, vol. 3), was designed to correct the error of law whereby said decision held that the rate of 31. 25 was still retained as first-grade rate for a disability requiring regular personal aid and attendance. This opinion, rendered April 15, 1890, upon a reconsideration of the former ruling, establishes the fact that the rate of 31. 25, which was created by the act of June 4, 1872, was abolished by the act of June 18, 1874, and the rate of 50 per month (first grade) provided in lieu of it. Assistant Secretary Bussey to the Commissioner of Pensions, April 15, 1890. I herewith return to you the papers in the claim of Rowland M. Jones (deceased), late second lientenant, Company A, Eleventh Pennsylvania Reserve Corps Volunteers (by Julia W. Jones, his widow), certificate No. 93845. I have re-examined the papers in this case for the purpose of determining whether or not there was error, as alleged, in the rating that was granted the deceased soldier in 1877, when his rate was increased from 11. 25 in 1873 to 31. 25 per month from February 14, 1877. The error alleged to have been made in the adjudication of the...
