The lessons in this book are designed to teach you the kind of informal, everyday speech—including many slang words as well as idioms—that is commonly understood by all native Americans, no matter what their level of education. There are various levels of idiomatic difficulty, and each group of lessons listed in the Table of Contents begins with the easiest lessons and ends with the more advanced ones.
