Thomas Ewing-Sir: -Your letter dated October 4th, 1862, was received in the form of a printed pamphlet of twenty-four pages, some ten days after its date. I regret exceedingly that you should have deemed it your duty to make yourself a party to a controversy in which Gen. Sherman has involved himself, without any necessity or excuse. He was not the Commander-in-Chief of the army at Shiloh, and was not named in any communication of mine as one of the officers who were responsible for the surprise, while other Generals were named. If therefore he finds himself worsted, the occasion does not justify you in coming to his aid, and making yourself a party to a controversy which he has unnecessarily provoked. From early life I have been accustomed to entertain the highest regard for your talents and character. It is therefore a matter of extreme regret to find myself compelled to engage in a public controversy with...
